# SIMPLE NO-CONTEST, NO-CHILDREN DIVORCE INSTRUCTIONS AND FORM COMPLETION CHECKLIST

Only if you can answer YES to the following questions should you attempt to use the forms in this package for a simple no-contest, no-children divorce. If you cannot answer all of the following questions with a YES answer, do not use this package of forms.

- 1. Were you married in a ceremonial marriage or are you claiming to be married as a Common Law husband and wife? By that, were you married by a Justice of the Peace, Judge, Magistrate, Minister, Pastor, Priest or other official authorized by the State of Texas to perform marriage ceremonies; *OR*, have you either filed a written statement of marriage with some governmental body, or have you declared to anyone who asks that you are in fact husband and wife?
- 2. Have either you or your spouse lived in the State of Texas for at least six months, and in this county for at least 90 days before you are filing for divorce?
- 3. Will your spouse agree to sign a Waiver (please ask to be sure)?
- 4. Have you and your spouse agreed to divide up your property and debts so that you each basically keep that which is in your possession or debts in your own respective names?

If the answer to all of the above questions is Yes, you may use this basic document package. Please complete the information in the checklist so that you will have everything you need for your divorce. Also, you <u>MUST</u> complete the Divorce Checklist for Pro Se Litigants that you may obtain from either the District Clerk or at <u>www.court506.com</u>.

Fill out your papers using a black or blue ink pen or a typewriter. **Print carefully and legibly.** You will need the following information in order to fill out the forms in this package. The person filing for the divorce is the Petitioner. The other spouse is the Respondent.

## **ORIGINAL PETITION FOR DIVORCE**

#### TO THE HONORABLE COURT:

## **IN-COURT TESTIMONY**

When your case is called, promptly approach the Judge and hand the Judge your Final Decree of Divorce. Then, raise your right hand to be sworn in. Ask if you may proceed.

#### READ THE FOLLOWING, CLEARLY AND LOUDLY ENOUGH FOR THE JUDGE TO HEAR:

Either the Respondent or I have been a resident of the State of Texas for at least six months and a resident of this county for at least 90 days before the petition for divorce was filed.

## FINAL DECREE OF DIVORCE

Petitioner appeared in person and announced ready for trial. Respondent has filed a waiver of citation in this matter which has been on file with the Court for at least ten days prior to this hearing. The making of a record in this matter was waived. All matters in controversy, including questions of fact and of law, were submitted to the Court.

The Court, having examined the pleadings and heard the evidence finds that the Court has jurisdiction over this cause and the parties and that the material allegations of the petition for dissolution of marriage are true.

IT IS, ACCORDINGLY, ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED as follows:

The marriage between Petitioner and Respondent is dissolved and a divorce is granted.

Petitioner is awarded all household furniture and furnishings, appliances, fixtures, goods, and equipment, and all clothing, jewelry, and other personal effects, in the possession of, or subject to the sole control of, Petitioner, including any sums of cash in the possession of, or subject to the sole control of, Petitioner, including money on account in banks, savings institutions, or other financial institutions, which accounts stand in Petitioner's sole name or from which Petitioner has the sole right to withdraw funds or which are subject to Petitioner's sole control as of the date of the decree.

Respondent is awarded all household furniture and furnishings, appliances, fixtures, goods, and equipment, and all clothing, jewelry, and other personal effects, in the possession of, or subject to the sole control of, Respondent, including any sums of cash in the possession of, or subject to the sole control of, Respondent, including money on account in banks, savings institutions, or other financial institutions, which accounts stand in Respondent's sole name or from which Respondent has the sole right to withdraw funds or which are subject to Respondent's sole control as of the date of the decree.

Any community property and other property referred to in Family Code Sections 7.001 and 7.002(a) not otherwise awarded by this decree is awarded to the party in possession or control of the property.

Petitioner is ordered to pay any and all debts against any of the property awarded to Petitioner. Respondent is ordered to pay any and all debts against any of the property awarded to Respondent.

Any community debt or liability not expressly assumed by or imposed on a party under this decree is to be paid by the party who incurred the debt or liability. No provision is made in this Decree for income tax liability, as none has been requested.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Petitioner and Respondent execute all instruments necessary to comply with and bring the terms of this decree into effect, and that Petitioner and Respondent have all necessary writs, execution, and process as is necessary to accomplish the execution and final disposition of this judgment.

All costs and fees shall be assessed against the party incurring them.
